## EPM is free to adopt stabilization measures for energy rates

- The measure covers users of the EPM electric energy service in Antioquia and the municipality of El Carmen de Atrato, in the department of Chocó
- It will be in effect for energy service rates until December 31, 2023
- The call to users is to efficiently use the electric energy service, because their monthly billing continues to depend on consumption

The EPM Board of Directors, in its meeting held Tuesday, May 23, gave Company Management the freedom to apply the stabilization of electric energy service rates until December 31, 2023.

This measure benefits over 7 million Colombians in the municipalities of the department of Antioquia and the municipality of El Carmen de Atrato (Chocó), positively impacting millions of homes and the national production chain.

"At a time when banks, supermarkets and other economic sectors are making efforts to contribute to the country's households, which are burdened by high inflation, our Company joins this decision to stabilize energy rates until December 31 of this year," said Jorge Andrés Carrillo Cardoso, CEO of EPM.
